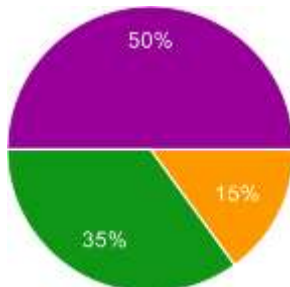


## Aberdeen City: Alcohol, Drug, & BBV Forum Evaluation Form

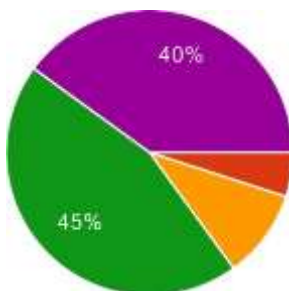

Question 1: Today's even was a useful exercise for myself



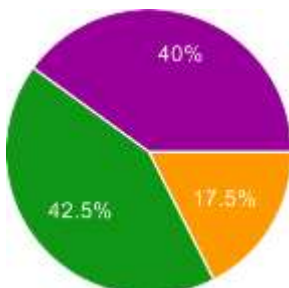
<b>Not at all</b>	0	0%
